OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY

In PDPM, every Skilled Med-A patient will be assigned an OT Component whether or not they receive OT treatment. The OT Component of a patient's per diem rate will consist of 3 factors:

- Clinical Category based off of patient's diagnosis that is the reason for the SNF stay.
- Function Score based off of a sum of 10 Section GG self-care and mobility items of the MDS.
- Variable Per Diem Adjustment Rate 2% reduction every 7 days after day 20.

Function Score is obtained from 10 items of Section GG on MDS: The higher the score the greater the independence; the lower the score the greater the dependence.

MDS Section GG Item	SCORE
Self-Care: Eating	0-4
Self-Care: Oral Hygiene	0-4
Self-Care: Toileting Hygiene	0-4
Mobility: Sit to lying	0-4 (average of 2 items)
Mobility: Lying to sitting on side of bed	
Mobility: Sit to stand	
Mobility: Chair/bed-to-chair transfer	0-4 (average of 3 items)
Mobility: Toilet transfer	
Mobility: Walk 50 feet with 2 turns	0-4 (average of 2 items)
Mobility: Walk 150 feet	
TOTAL:	0-24

OT Case Mix Group and Case Mix Index: Every patient will be assigned a Case Mix Group that is dependent on the OT Clinical Category and the patient's Function Score from section GG of the MDS.

The Case Mix Index is a base number, think of it as a weighted score. This weighted score will then be multiplied by a set variable to determine the OT Component per diem rate for each patient.

OT Variable Per-Diem Adjustment Rate: The OT Component consists of a full rate of reimbursement for days 1-20. There will be a 2% reduction in the per diem rate for OT every 7 days after day 20 because CMS feels the cost associated with services OT delivers is diminished throughout the patient's skilled stay.
